COUNTERS AND TIMERS FOR DISTANCE EVENTS

Counters are required for events 500 yards and over. In addition, swimmers must provide their own timers for the 1000 free (AM only) and 1650 free.

DECK CREDENTIALS

Credentials will be required for entry onto the deck. Everyone receiving a Credential will be required to show current USA Swimming Membership, and all coaches will be required to show current and valid Coaching Credentials. Coaches' packets and credentials for athletes and officials will be available in the entrance area on the lower pool level starting at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday. Thursday and Friday, packets will be available starting at 7:15 a.m. Saturday morning, please see the Meet Director.

COACHES CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

USA SWIMMING COMPETITOR WAIVER and RELEASE


All parent/guardians and swimmers must complete the USA Swimming Competitor Waiver and Release form electronically by <u>clicking here</u>. Please fill out a new form for each swimmer you have competing. A copy of this form will be automatically sent to us so there is no need to bring a physical copy with you to the meet.

WEDNESDAY WARM-UP PERIOD

There will be an opportunity to practice in open lanes from 2:00-4:00 PM and warm up from 4 PM to 20 minutes after the session ends. The Wednesday practice and warmup rules will be posted on the hosted page.

PARKING NOTICE

Because school is in session on Thursday during prelims and the 10&U timed finals, parking is restricted to the lot directly across from the main entrance to the pool or the remote lot to the east near the fields. The remaining lots are for school use only. Parking on the grass or in the fire lane striping is prohibited at all times. Illegally parked cars may be towed at the owner's expense.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES

POSITIVE CHECK IN EVENTS

Positive check-in is required for all age groups in the following individual events for preliminary or timed finals sessions: 400 IM, 500 Free, 1000 Free and 1650 Free, and all Wednesday events (including relays). Positive check-in closes at 3:30 PM for Wednesday's session and 45 minutes prior to the session's start for the other events. Remote check in will be available for Wednesday's check in, please email zoneoperations@fairportswimming.com or text (585) 364-2557 with your swimmer's intentions.

SCRATCH PROCEDURE FOR FINALS

In accordance with USA Swimming rules. 207.11.6. A-E, Scratches, or Intent to Scratch from Finals must be reported to the Officials table no later than 30 minutes following the announcement of the preliminary results. Athletes who declare an Intent to Scratch have 30 minutes after their last event to decide. **Athletes who declare an Intent to Scratch and do not return and make a formal scratch will be seeded into Finals**. No formal scratching is necessary for preliminary swims.
