• Located in the lobby and upstairs balcony. No entry is permitted into locker rooms at ANY time.



#### **Parking**

- Thursday & Friday Prelims +
   10 & Under Sessions:
  - BLUE Lots Only
- All Other Sessions:
  - Any Available Lot (Red and Blue Lots)

#### **First Aid**

Some sessions may have EMT's on site, otherwise it will be provided by the WAC lifeguard staff.

#### **Ready Room**

- 'A' finalists will stage in the ready room and will be paraded out to music. NO RELAYS.
- 10 & under top-8 finalists will stage by the podium.
- Wednesday's events will not be walked out. Saturday's fastest 1000 freestyle heat will walk out.

#### **Hospitality Room**

- For coaches, officials, and meet personnel only. Overflow seating may be in the ready room.
- Please be considerate of others and their eating schedules.

#### **Deck Entrance**

Coaches and officials ONLY! Coaches, scan your badge in EVERY TIME you enter the deck.

#### **Restricted Areas**

 No parents, coaches, and officials are permitted in the locker rooms or back hallway. Failure to follow will result in loss of deck access.

- 10 & under awards will be presented during each respective session.

#### **Lane Timing Assignments**

- Participating clubs are required to provide lane timers for the preliminary and 10 & under sessions.
   Assignments will be posted on the hosted meet page.
- A SignUpGenius will be created for families to sign up to be a timer. General Sign Ups will also be available.
- Timers are expected to stay through the session, including distance events.
- Announcements will be made throughout the facility for teams who still need to provide lane timers.
- FAST will provide lane timers for all final sessions.

#### **Team Packet Pickup**

- Packets will be available for pickup in the lobby of the WAC beginning at 2:00 p.m.
- Included in the packets are your:
  - Wednesday Relay Cards
  - Athlete Credentials

#### **Bleacher Assignments**

#### **Coach Check In Process**

- Utilizing an electronic coach check in process.
- Link is available on the hosted meet page and in the pre-meet communication.
- Fill this out BEFORE arriving to the meet to speed up the process.
- Once verified at the check in desk, you'll receive your credential and team packet.
- You must scan your badge every time you enter the deck.

#### **Heat Sheets**

Will be available in the hospitality room for every session.

#### **Warm-Up Procedures**

- The Niagara LSC warm-up procedures will be followed.
- Lanes will not be assigned. Please be courteous and mindful if the pool is busy.
- Start & Pace lanes will open 30 minutes prior to the meet start:
  - 1 & 10: Pace
  - 2, 3, 8, and 9: Starts
  - 4, 5, 6, and 7: General Warm-Up
- During the warm-up period, both the shallow and deep end are open.
- During the meet, the shallow end will be closed, the meet end will remain open.

### 12 & Under Tech Suit Restriction



#### Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules & Regulations 102.8.1.F:

- No Technical Suits shall be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved or observed meet.
- A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:
  - a. Any suit with any bonded or taped seams regardless of its fabric or silhouette;-or-
  - b. Any suit with woven fabric extending past the hips.

### **Finals**



#### 11-14 Age Group

- Top 16 in prelims will return to finals after scratches:
  - **A** final: 1-8<sup>th</sup>, **B** final: 9-16<sup>th</sup>
  - The 'A' finalist will line up in the ready room and will be paraded out.
  - #1 seed gets to pick out their walk out music. Content must be appropriate and will be monitored. Otherwise, we will pick a song from our list.
  - Swimmers will clear the pool after the conclusion of each race.
  - Failure to show at finals will result in the swimmer being barred from further competition, unless the swimmer was NOT in the top 16 announced after prelims.
  - 8 lane format will be utilized.

#### 10 & Under Age Group

- Top 8 in each event will line up stage behind the meet operations table for an awards presentation on the podium.
- All events are timed finals and will be swum in the afternoon sessions.
- 10 lane format will be utilized.

500 free, 1650 free, 400 Free Relays, 400 IM, and 1000 free.

#### **Check In Deadlines**

- Wednesday Events by 3:30 p.m.
- Other Events must be checked in 45 minutes prior to the session's start time for each event.
